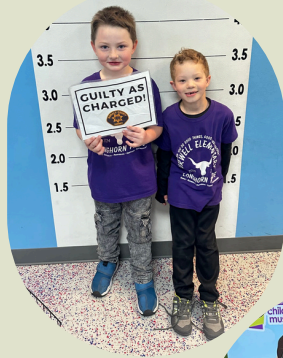

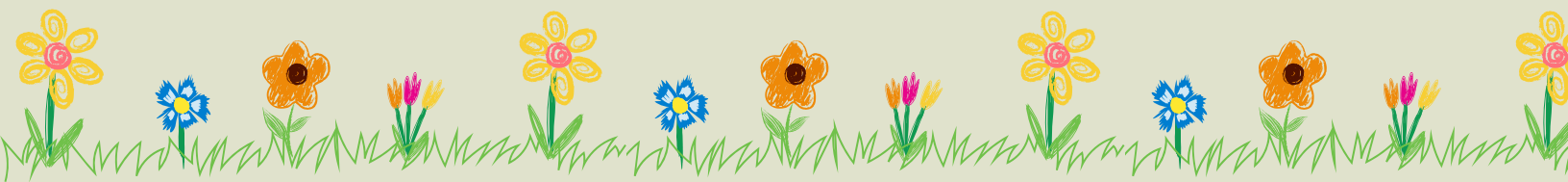
Kindergarten news

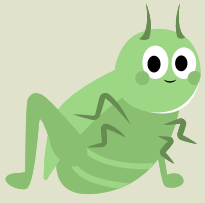

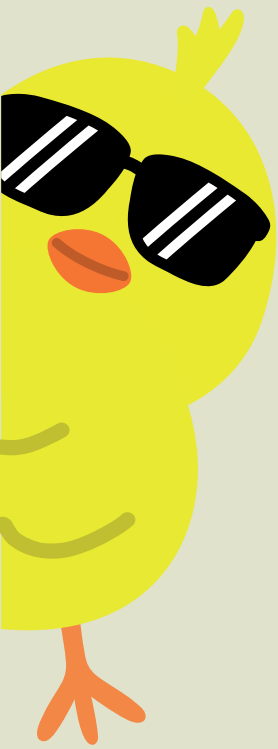
Science has us learning that there has to be a vibration for a sound to be made. We practiced making & changing sounds with rubber bands and rulers.



In Math, we are solving addition word problems with a missing addend. We are continuing learning our addition & subtraction facts.



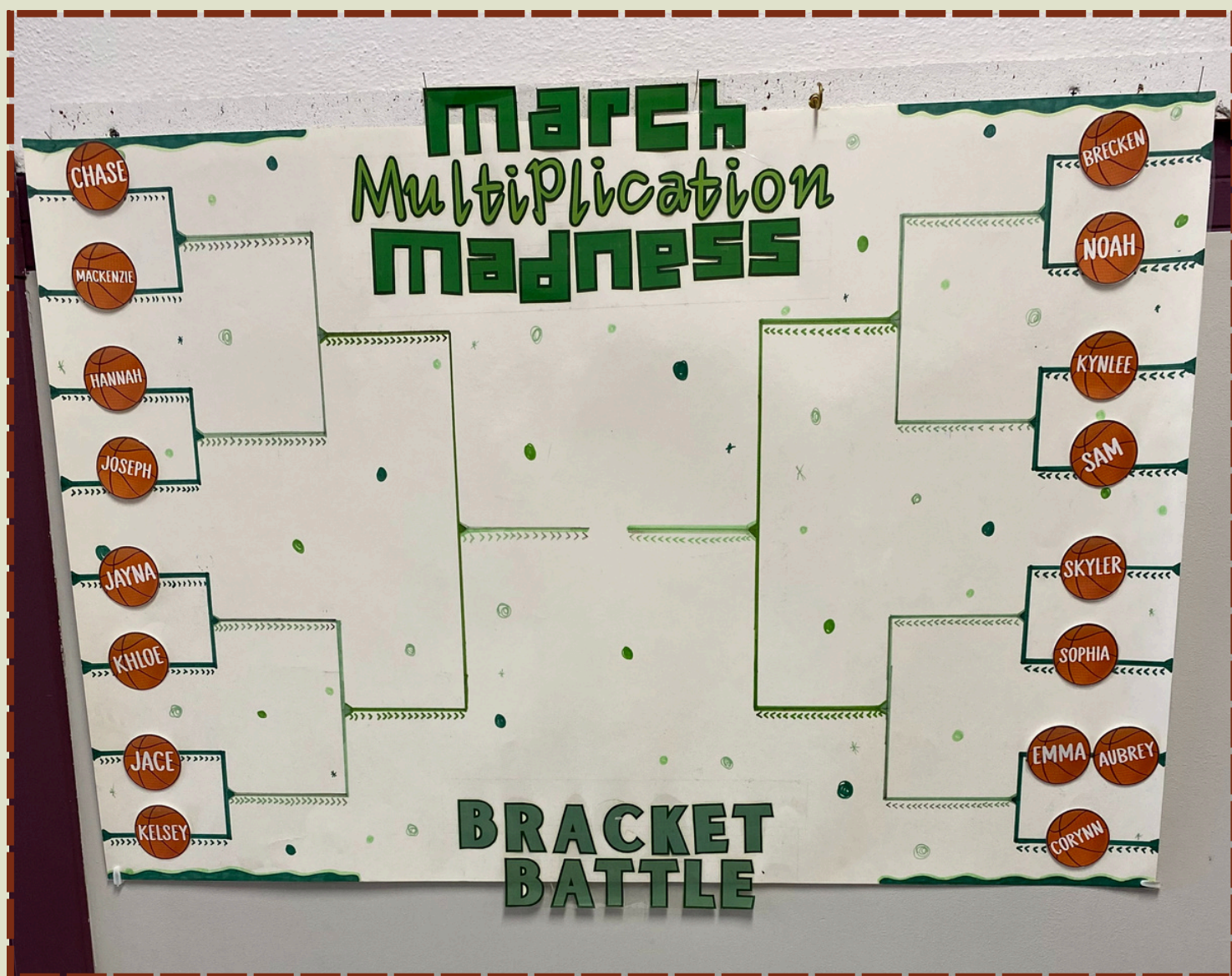

Mrs. Swett and the 5th grade class have set their March Madness Multiplication bracket.



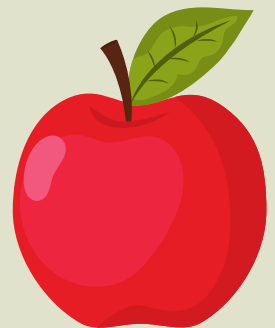
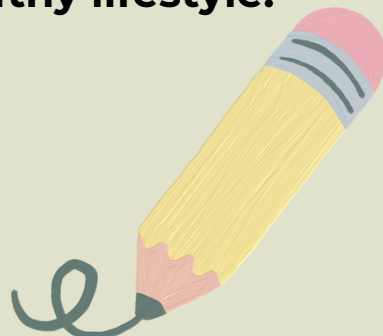
TOO GOOD FOR DRUGS.

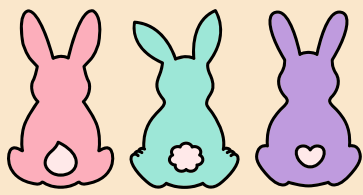

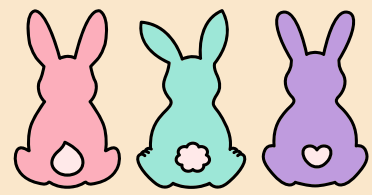
