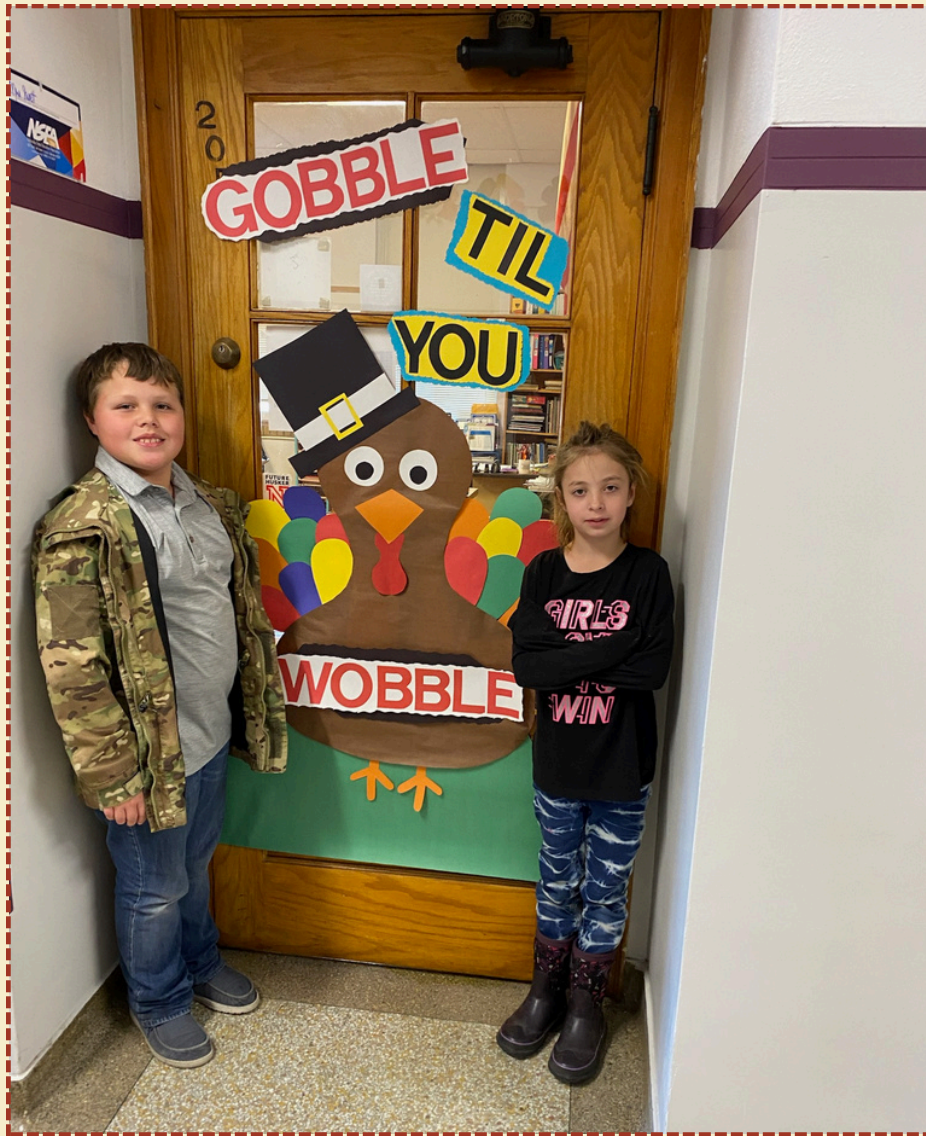


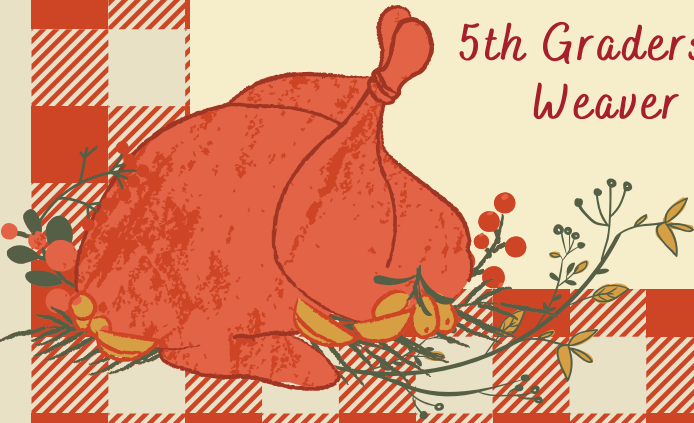

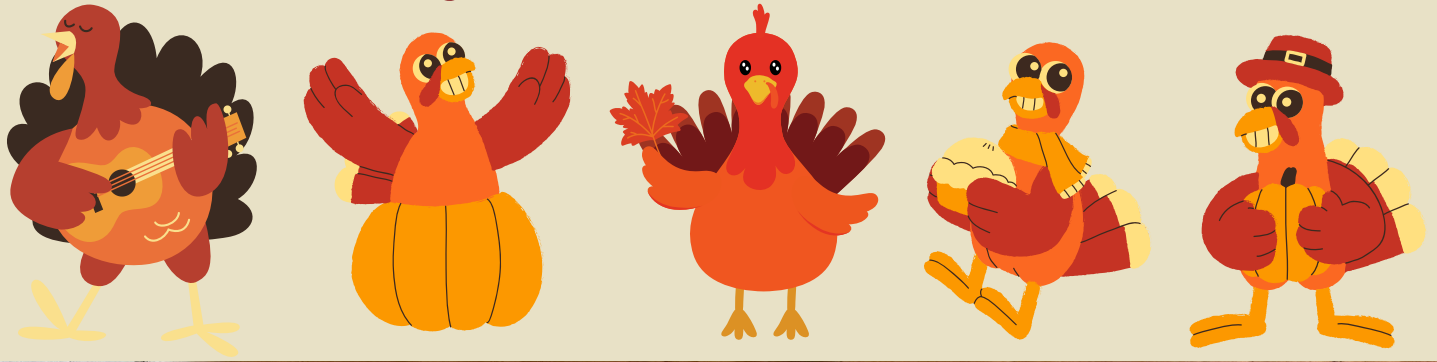
# October Longhorn Pride Winners

# 1<sup>ST</sup> Grade Fun

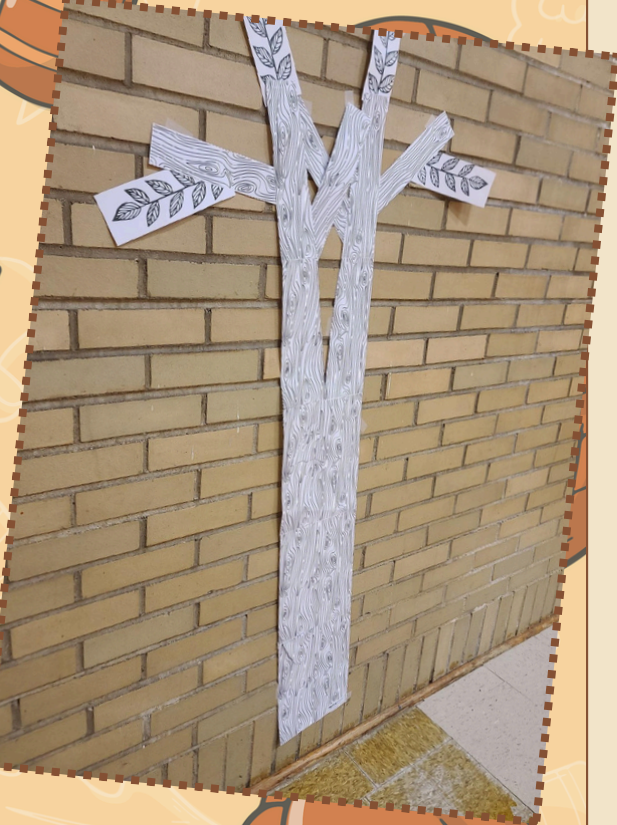

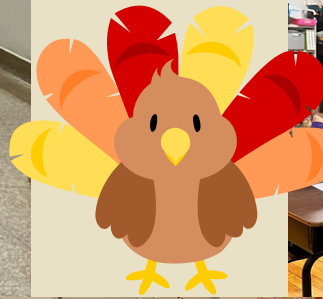
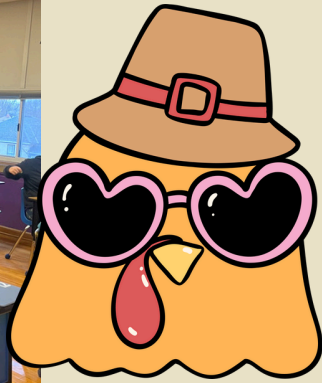
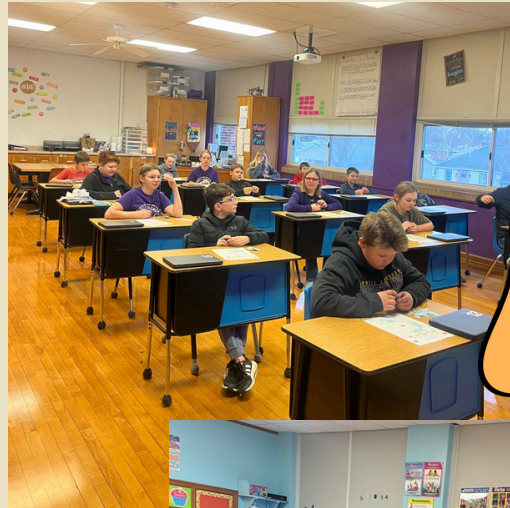


# Turkey Bingo
